

FIFTY-SIX TRAILER RENTALS LLC

RENTAL FEE SCHEDULE

Version 1.0 - Effective Date: August 13, 2026

This Fee Schedule is incorporated into and forms part of each applicable Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC rental transaction.

The rental price for the specific trailer and rental period will be stated on the applicable Trailer Checkout & Return Sheet. This Fee Schedule primarily establishes additional charges that may apply as a result of late return, damage, cleaning, missing equipment, unauthorized use, recovery, or other circumstances described below.

Charges apply only when authorized by the Master Trailer Rental Agreement, applicable rental documents, and applicable law.

1. SECURITY DEPOSIT

Standard Security Deposit

Normally Not Required

Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC does not normally require a security deposit for standard rentals.

Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC reserves the right to require a security deposit based on reasonable rental-risk considerations, including trailer type or value, rental duration, payment method, renter history, intended use, or other circumstances reasonably affecting the rental risk.

Any required security deposit and its amount will be disclosed and agreed upon before checkout and identified on the Trailer Checkout & Return Sheet.

Application of a security deposit does not limit Renter's responsibility for amounts otherwise properly due under the rental agreement.

2. UNAUTHORIZED LATE RETURN

Grace Period

30 Minutes

No late-return fee applies during the first 30 minutes following the scheduled return time.

Late-Return Fee

\$50 per hour or portion thereof after the 30-minute grace period

The maximum late-return fee per rental day is the greater of \$200 or the trailer's applicable daily rental rate.

The late-return fee is separate from any applicable additional rental-period charges.

Extensions approved by Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC before the scheduled return time are not considered unauthorized late returns. Applicable extension or additional rental charges may still apply.

Reasonable recovery or other direct costs caused by an unauthorized late return may be charged separately when applicable.

3. EXCESSIVE CLEANING

Excessive Cleaning Fee

\$125 Minimum

Applies when a trailer is returned in a condition requiring cleaning beyond normal rental turnover, including excessive mud, trash, grease, oil, construction debris, animal waste, or similar materials or contamination.

Ordinary cleaning associated with normal and proper use is not chargeable.

4. HEAVY OR HAZARDOUS CONTAMINATION

Minimum Charge

\$125 Minimum + Additional Reasonable Costs

When contamination requires substantial additional labor, specialized cleaning materials, disposal, remediation, environmental services, or third-party services, Renter may be responsible for the \$125 minimum charge plus reasonable additional labor,

cleaning materials, disposal costs, remediation costs, and third-party expenses.

5. TIRE OR WHEEL DAMAGE

Damage Charge

\$50 Minimum Per Damaged Tire or Wheel + Actual Repair/Replacement Cost and Applicable Labor

Applies to tire or wheel damage for which Renter is responsible under the Master Trailer Rental Agreement.

Ordinary wear, normal service-life failure, and pre-existing defects are not chargeable to Renter.

6. DAMAGED OR MISSING ACCESSORIES

Service Fee

\$50 + Actual Repair or Replacement Cost

Applies to Company-owned equipment that is lost, missing, not returned, or damaged beyond ordinary wear, including straps, chains, wheel chocks, dollies, adapters, locks, and other supplied accessories or equipment.

Where a more specific charge for an item is stated elsewhere in this Fee Schedule, the specific charge will apply instead of a duplicative general accessory service fee.

7. TRAILER DAMAGE

Damage Administration Fee

\$75 + Parts and Labor

When Renter is responsible for damage to the trailer under the Master Trailer Rental Agreement, a \$75 damage administration fee may apply in addition to reasonable repair costs.

Repair costs may include parts, materials, Company repair labor, third-party repair invoices, and other reasonable direct repair expenses.

Applicable towing, recovery, and loss-of-use charges are addressed separately below.

8. REPAIR LABOR

Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC Repair Labor

\$75 Per Hour

When repairs for renter-responsible damage are performed internally by Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC, labor will be charged at \$75 per hour.

Third-party repairs will be charged at actual invoiced cost.

9. TOWING AND RECOVERY

Administration Fee

\$50 + Applicable Recovery Costs

When towing or recovery is required because of circumstances for which Renter is responsible, Renter may be charged a \$50 administration fee plus actual third-party towing, recovery, storage, impoundment, and related costs.

If Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC performs the recovery directly, Renter may instead be charged reasonable documented labor, mileage, fuel, and other direct recovery expenses, in addition to the \$50 administration fee.

This charge does not apply when recovery is required solely because of a mechanical failure or other condition for which Renter is not responsible.

10. UNAUTHORIZED USE OR GEOGRAPHIC VIOLATION

Administration Fee

\$50 + Reasonable Actual Costs

Unauthorized use or operation outside the geographic limits established by the Master Trailer Rental Agreement may result in a \$50 administration fee plus reasonable actual costs resulting from the violation, including applicable towing, recovery, storage,

mileage, fuel, labor, and other direct expenses.

Unauthorized use or geographic travel may also constitute a material breach of the Master Trailer Rental Agreement and may result in termination of the rental and demand for immediate return of the trailer.

Failure or refusal to return the trailer following termination or demand for return may be referred to law enforcement when warranted and handled in accordance with applicable law.

11. LOST KEY

Replacement Charge

\$15 Per Key

Covers replacement of a lost Company-owned key and reasonable time associated with obtaining or making the replacement key.

12. LOST LOCK

Replacement Charge

\$50 Per Lock

Applies when a Company-owned lock is lost, not returned, or rendered unusable.

This specific charge applies instead of the general damaged/missing-accessory service fee for the same lock.

13. RETURNED OR FAILED PAYMENT

Administration Fee

\$25 + Outstanding Amount Due

A \$25 administration fee may apply to a returned check or other failed payment, subject to applicable law.

Renter remains responsible for the underlying outstanding amount.

A good-faith credit/debit card dispute or chargeback is not automatically treated as a returned or failed payment solely because a dispute was initiated.

14. UNAUTHORIZED AFTER-HOURS ACTIVITY

Charge

\$50

Applies to an unauthorized after-hours pickup, return, access, or other rental-related activity requiring a response from Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC.

No after-hours charge applies when the activity was authorized or arranged in advance by Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC.

15. TRAILER ABANDONMENT

Administration Fee

\$75 + Applicable Recovery Costs

Applies when Renter leaves or abandons the trailer at a location other than the authorized return location without approval from Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC.

Renter may also be responsible for reasonable towing, recovery, storage, mileage, fuel, labor, and other direct expenses resulting from the abandonment.

The separate \$50 Towing & Recovery administration fee will not also be charged when the \$75 abandonment administration fee applies to the same event.

16. LOSS OF USE

Charge

Applicable Established Rental Rate for the Reasonable Period of Lost Availability

When renter-responsible damage prevents a trailer from being available for rental, Renter may be responsible for loss of use to the extent authorized by the Master Trailer Rental Agreement and applicable law.

Loss of use will be calculated using the applicable established daily, weekend, weekly, or other applicable rental rate for the reasonable period during which the trailer is unavailable.

For example, when a trailer is reasonably unavailable for seven days, the applicable weekly rental rate will ordinarily be used rather than seven separate daily rental charges.

The loss-of-use period shall be limited to the reasonable time necessary to inspect the trailer, obtain parts, schedule repairs, and complete repairs.

17. NON-DUPLICATION OF ADMINISTRATION FEES

When a single event could reasonably fall within more than one administration-fee category in this Fee Schedule, Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC will not impose multiple administration fees for substantially the same administrative work.

This does not prevent Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC from charging separate reasonable actual costs, repair costs, rental charges, loss-of-use amounts, or other amounts properly due under the rental agreement.

18. DOCUMENTATION AND FINAL CHARGES

When reasonably available, Fifty-Six Trailer Rentals LLC will maintain documentation supporting post-rental charges, which may include checkout and return inspection records, photographs or video, repair estimates, parts receipts, third-party invoices, labor records, towing or recovery records, and other relevant documentation.

Some charges may not be known at the time the trailer is returned.

Final damage, repair, recovery, contamination, or loss-of-use charges may be determined after additional inspection, diagnosis, estimates, parts pricing, repair completion, or insurance review.

19. PAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY

Renter remains responsible for amounts properly due under the applicable Master Trailer Rental Agreement, Trailer Checkout & Return Sheet, this Fee Schedule, and other documents incorporated into the rental transaction.

Payment of an administration fee does not eliminate responsibility for actual repair, replacement, recovery, rental, loss-of-use, or other applicable costs unless expressly stated otherwise.

FEE SCHEDULE ACKNOWLEDGMENT

This Fee Schedule does not require a separate signature.

Renter's acceptance of the applicable Fee Schedule is documented through the signed Trailer Checkout & Return Sheet.

Each Trailer Checkout & Return Sheet shall identify or provide access to the applicable Fee Schedule and Master Trailer Rental Agreement incorporated into that rental.

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
